The high-end Japanese food hall features four full-service dining experience: **Dear Sushi**, an omakase experience where traditional "old-school" goes head to head out with envelope-pushing "new-school" sushi; **Beloved BBQ**, a Japanese Yakiniky experience where patrons grill their own mealf; **Hiya Izakaya**, a cocktail bar featuring whiskey highballs, sake, beer, skewers and bites prepared over a robata grill offering daily happy hour from 4 - 6 p.m.; lastly, **Love on the Run**, the quick serve concept featuring sushi, salad, ramen, soba noodles, sandwiches and donuts, all made from scratch.
